

Senior All-Star Game Player Instructions

1. All players selected for the Senior All-Star Game should report to the Nationwide Arena Security Office underneath the building in the loading dock area Saturday morning by 8:45 AM. Parking for the Senior All Star Game will be in the attached parking garage at the north end of Nationwide Arena. Parking for players is free as long as you use that garage. If you park in any other lot or garage around the Arena, you are on your own. The Blue Jackets will not be able to help you as they only have authorization for free parking in the attached garage. Get a parking ticket as you entered the garage, and bring it with you when you enter at security in order to get it validated. Only one parking ticket per player can be validated. Once inside Security, a Blue Jackets representative will meet you, give you your jersey and escort you to the appropriate locker room. Please be on time.
2. There is no charge for families, friends and fans to attend the All-Star Game.
3. Each player will receive two (2) complimentary tickets to attend the OHSAA semi-final games scheduled to start at 1:00 PM that afternoon.
4. Jerseys, which the players can keep, will be provided by the Blue Jackets. Players should bring all other equipment including both home and away socks.
5. Any player who is nominated for the All-Star game, but is participating in one of the OHSAA State Semi-Final Games, will not be able to participate in the All-Star game. However, they will receive their All-Star jersey.
